

ONE-STOP ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM UPDATE No. 2
Information regarding Technology Requests
2/02/10

At this time, there are currently three initiatives being administered by the ODJFS – Workforce Solutions Division that pertain to purchase of technology/equipment in the local areas:

- 1) The One-Stop Enhancement Program administered by the Office of Workforce Development that focuses on improvements to One-Stop Resource Rooms, Computer Labs, and/or satellite sites. These equipment and technology updates are focused on the job seeker and business customers.
- 2) The Unemployment Compensation/Trade Program Upgrade administered by the Office of UC that focuses on increasing the capacity of the Trade and Reemployment Programs through the purchase of additional laptops/PCs, scanners, and other equipment to ensure customers of those programs are being served quickly and efficiently.
- 3) The Office of Local Operations equipment upgrades to assist with the BESI and other assessments, the processing/call centers, and other sites where customers in need of services are being served. These upgrades mostly focus on staff assisted services.

Each program can potentially support the One-Stop sites and all three offices would like to ensure that efforts are being coordinated so that each local workforce area can better serve customers while reducing any redundancy or duplication of equipment requests.

Please ensure that you check with your local technical point of contact and/or with the ODJFS technical support representative (see Program Update No. 1) prior to submitting your One-Stop Enhancement Program plans to ensure all efforts have been taken into account. This may be aided in the local areas by the site surveys that the UC/Trade Program will be conducting shortly over the next six to eight weeks. In addition, the three offices will be sharing equipment purchase information on a regular basis as a further step of coordination to reduce duplication or excess purchases.
